



Really Living Van

Passenger Information, Waiver & Consent

Really Living's van ministry is a service provided for church members and friends who do not have transportation of their own. Its primary purpose is to provide transportation to and from Sabbath church services, and to and from Friday night youth meetings and special events.

Space in the van is limited to the number of functional seatbelts (maximum 11 passengers + 1 driver). If more individuals require rides than what the van can accommodate, preference will be given to elderly attendees, those with physical limitations, and those for whom the cost of public transit might be a hardship.

This service is provided free of charge to passengers, but donations towards its upkeep are greatly appreciated and can be made either through the church website or at our regular Sabbath services.

Your Responsibilities as a Passenger:

Please respect the driver's authority to enforce van usage policies.

Please be on time for scheduled pick-ups. The van cannot wait. Please call the transportation coordinator or van driver as soon as possible if your plans change and you cannot make your scheduled pick-up.

You are required to wear a seat belt at all times while the vehicle is operating. If you refuse to wear a seatbelt the driver is instructed to prohibit you from riding in the van. Any tickets incurred for failure to wear a seatbelt will be the responsibility of the passenger.

Provincial regulations will be enforced in regard to the safe transport of children and infants. If a car seat or booster seat is required by law, it must be supplied *and installed* by the parent(s) or someone they have designated. Drivers are not trained in the proper installation of car seats.

Food and drink cannot be consumed in the van except in special approved circumstances.

Pick up and drop off locations and times must be pre-arranged. Due to insurance and liability issues the van cannot be used to take you to out-of-the-way errands, or drop you off at locations outside the agreed upon route.

There is limited storage space in the van when it is at maximum occupancy. **Please keep personal items to a minimum.**
