Grandview Adventist Academy School Student Aid Program

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your consideration of Grandview Adventist Academy (GAA) as your school of choice for the education of your child(ren). If you have already made the decision to enroll; welcome aboard!

The decision to invest in private education can result in financial implications, and in some cases families may be eligible for student aid.

Commencing with the 2017-2018 academic year all GAA subsidy requests for members of Really Living SDA church must be directed to:

Due to the sensitive nature of the material, all letters will be forwarded by the Board, unopened, to a subcommittee comprised of the church pastor, treasurer and a designated elder for review and processing.

It is important to note that all student aid requests must be submitted to the above address by no later than May 31 prior to the next school year. Requests submitted after this date will not be accepted.

Enclosed are two documents to assist you in determining if your family might qualify for student subsidy:

- 1) "Criteria for Granting Student Aid for Adventist Education" (Document 1)
- 2) "Student Aid Calculation Tables". (Document 2)

Also enclosed is the application form that must be turned in with the proper documentation required.

Eligibility criteria for GAA Adventist Education

(edited/approved May 18, 2020)

1. Availability of funds based on a set yearly budget. If demands exceed budget, the finance committee will have to deal with each case individually.
2. Applicant must be an active & participating member of Really Living Seventh-day Adventist church
3. Applicant must provide their current year of notice of assessment to substantiate their need for assistance
4. Maximum assistance given will be limited to 50% of tuition
5. Tuition assistance granted will be paid Monthly
6. Applicants receiving student aid will be reviewed mid-year to determine continuing eligibility. If subsidized parents fail to be faithful in their portion of the monthly payment, Really Living has the right to stop paying the subsidy.

* This subsidy only applies to GAA. Any SDA high school or university subsidy will comply with the updated schedule of RLSDA in regards to denominational three-way matching fund.

Financial Schedule

(edited/approved May 18, 2020)

Note: The % is of total tuition for the year regardless of # of children, but does not include busing fees.

(Ex: If you have 2 children attending GAA and your total annual combined income is less than \$61,000.00 but more than \$56,000.00, then RLSDA will subsidize up to 30% of total tuition.)

Note: Number of children means number of children in any Seventh-day-Adventist educational institution. (Ex: If you have 2 children at GAA and 1 in P.A.C.E.S or Burman, you qualify for the 3 children subsidy)
