Dear Parents,

Thank you for your consideration of Grandview Adventist Academy (GAA) as your school of choice for the education of your child(ren). If you have already made the decision to enroll, welcome aboard!

The decision to invest in private education can result in financial implications, and in some cases families may be eligible for student aid.

Due to the sensitive nature of the material, requests will be forwarded by the Board unopened to a subcommittee consisting of the lead pastor, treasurer, and designated elder, for review and processing.

It is important to note that all student aid requests must be submitted no later than May 31, prior to the start of the school year for which the subsidy is requested. Requests submitted after this date will not be accepted.

Please ensure that you review the eligibility info and financial schedule before completing the request form. After review, should you have any questions or concerns, please contact the church office for assistance.

STUDENT AID FOR GRANDVIEW ADVENTIST ACADEMY

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & INFORMATION

- Availability of funds is based on a set yearly budget. If demands exceed budget, the finance committee will consider cases on an individual basis.
- Applicants must be active & participating members of Really Living Seventh-day Adventist Church.
- Applicants must provide their current year's notice(s) of assessment to substantiate their need for assistance. Maximum assistance given will be limited to 50% of tuition.
- Tuition assistance granted will be paid monthly.
- Applicants receiving student aid will be reviewed mid-year to determine continuing eligibility.
- If subsidized parents fail to be faithful in their portion of the monthly payment to GAA, Really Living has the right to stop paying the subsidy.
- This subsidy formula only applies to attendance at GAA. Three-way matching scholarship requests from other Adventist high schools or universities will follow a separate formula.
